



## Looking to transfer to UGA to pursue a degree in Poultry Science?

## We're here to help. Follow these guidelines to ensure you are on track for a BSA Poultry Science degree at the University of Georgia:

Students who complete CORE at ABAC (Areas A–E) will complete CORE for a UGA degree (Areas 1–5) since both institutions follow the USG CORE to CORE policy. Area F or Area 6 (for UGA) will be dependent on the major you have declared at ABAC. Further guidance on this section can be provided by an academic advisor.

Within your CORE options you will want to complete the following to ensure you are meeting requirements for our degree as well. Some of the courses below may not be featured in the CORE, but are required as pre-requisites for the Poultry Science degree. If you cannot take these courses before transferring they can be taken at UGA.

- COMM 1110 (Public Speaking)
- HIST 2111 or HIST 2112 (US History)
- POLS 1101 (American Government)
- ECON 2106 or AECO 2258 (Microeconomics or Applied Economics)
- CHEM 1211/L (Principles of Chemistry I)
- BIOL 1107/L + BIOL 1108/L (Principles of Biology I + II)
- MATH 1113 (pre-calculus) or either College Algebra AND College Trigonometry (see note below)
- MATH 1401 (Statistics)
- ACCT 2101 (Accounting I)

There may be additional University Requirements students must meet once they transfer to UGA that cannot be covered by ABAC coursework (i.e. cultural diversity, experiential learning, environmental literacy, or physical education).

\*MATH Requirement: UGA will either accept MATH 1113 or allow the completion of BOTH College Algebra and College Trigonometry to count for the MATH requirement.

If you plan to transfer to the University of Georgia's Department of Poultry Science for any of our four undergraduate degrees, it is highly recommended to set up a transfer plan with one of our Academic Advisors as soon as possible. To do so, please contact Jessica Fife via email.
